Derived terms

Terms derived from the Proto-Indo-European root *deh2-

- *dh₂-yé-tor
 - Proto-Albanian: *daja
 - Albanian: daj
 - Proto-Hellenic: *dayomai
 - Ancient Greek: δαίωμα (daíomai)
 - Proto-Indo-Iranian: *dáyatay
 - Proto-Indo-Aryan: *dáyatay
 - Sanskrit: दयते (dáyate)
- *deh₂-mo-s
 - Proto-Hellenic: *dāmos
 - Ancient Greek: δήμος (dêmos) (*see there for further descendants*)
- *deh₂-lom
 - Proto-Celtic: *dālom (*see there for further descendants*)
